This beautiful and modern bar, located on the Dress Circle, is bathed in natural light from windows overlooking St. Martin's Lane, and features a fully-equipped bar.



The Balcony Bar has a working lighting rig which can be hired on request, making it the perfect venue for meetings and presentations.


The Clore Space and Trafalgar Room can be neatly partitioned from the main Balcony Bar to offer a break-out space during a conference.

The Clore Space is a warm room that can be closed off entirely from the adjoining Balcony Bar.


